Casa

The light installation 'Casa' is inspired from a weaver bird's nest. The warm light glow coming from the egg-shape marbled glass adds a sense of life to the installation. It is constructed with the homogeneous blend of approximately 4,500 mirror finished stainless steel balls. The construction of Casa is complex as each stainless steel ball is welded to the next, one by one, slowly acquiring the organic form which has complex curves.





Drape

Free-flowing contour of fabric metamorphoses into a metallic drape which is inspired by a sensuous form. Beaded twines of metal come together in an asymmetrical formation that transforms into this luminescent delight.

Shell

Inspired by the conch shell, this piece captures the essence of life and nature. Fluid curves of the conch-form combine with the solidity of the lustrous beads to create a shape. This mercurial symbol of purity can liven up any space - indoor as well as outdoor.
